When a disaster strikes, the burden of responding to a pandemic influenza falls primarily on first responders, such as emergency medical service personnel, law enforcement officers, public health officials, and healthcare workers. In order to lessen disastrous effects caused by influenza pandemic, first responders and emergency services personnel must have the knowledge and skills to implement sound and valid disease control measures and implement activities to ensure a sustainable medical healthcare system.

On January 9, 2008, Polk County, Florida, responders were confronted with a worst case scenario as 70 vehicles collided in zero-visibility conditions along a heavily traveled interstate highway. The lessons learned in Polk County will benefit responders nationwide who may face similar situations in their jurisdictions.
