#### **Terrorism in the Middle East, Part 3: Palestinian Terrorist Groups**

Israel and Palestine have been in conflict since the late 1940s when Britain turned the Palestinian lands over to the United Nations. This module explains how the Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO) was formed and tracks the development of Fatah. We highlight nine major resistance groups, describing their violent lifestyles and what motivates them. We then look at the threats that face Americans increasingly since the 9/11 attacks.

#### **WMD — What Every Officer Should Know, Part 4: Chemical Weapons**

This program provides law enforcement officers with an overview of chemical weapons. After a brief historical summary, we describe the four common categories of chemical weapons, routes of exposure, symptoms of exposure, possible long-term health effects, and actions to take if exposure to these agents occurs.

National Organization for Women* to find out: Does requiring sex offenders to register violate the 14th Amendment?
